ACTIVITY TITLE: Gender stereotypes

AIM OF THE ACTIVITY: Improve students' speaking skills and increase their vocabulary related to gender stereotypes. Agree, disagree and increase the use of contrast links (however; but; on the other hand...)

ESTIMATED DURATION: 45 min

MATERIALS NEEDED: Projector and sheets for students

ATTACHED DOCUMENTS: Gender stereotypes / What makes a good marriage

SUGGESTED LEVEL: B2

PROCEDURE:

1.- GENDER STEREOTYPES PAGE 1. (15 min)

Teacher hands in the sheet and presents the activity to students. They gather in groups of four and discuss the questions. They have to try to get to conclusions that they will have to present the rest of the groups. Each group present conclusions to the rest of the class. Teacher writes each new idea in the blackboard and highlights the ones that are common to all the groups.

2.- GENDER STEREOTYPES PAGE 2. (15 min)

Teacher presents the different stereotypes in the sheet. Students gather in groups of four and discuss them using contrast links. Groups may try to establish to what extent such stereotypes are true. Then they explain the class if they have or haven't been able to agree.

3.- WHAT MAKES A GOOD MARRIAGE (10 MIN)

Students gather in pairs and discuss the question with the help of the sheet. Then teacher writes all new ideas and highlight the ones that are common. The teacher will marl as essential the elements chosen in every pair.
